



## LOTE Term 4 Overview Chinese

### Year One

Students will learn how to say and write the name of some familiar pets. They will create some simple sentences to introduce all members in their family. In addition, students will also explore a general understanding of the Giant Panda and a general understanding of two traditional Chinese festivals.

### Year Two

Students will learn to speak, read and write some basic clothing words. They will draw on their knowledge and understanding from term three to describe their favourite clothes. Students will also explore a general understanding of two traditional Chinese festivals.

### Year Three

Students will learn to write some simple personal information, such as their name, age, grade, birthday, family members and pets. The main focus will be on the awareness of Chinese character writing and counting numbers to 30. In addition, students will also explore a general understanding of two traditional Chinese festivals.

### Year Four

Students will learn to speak and write a simple passage about themselves. The passage will include their name, age, grade and interests/hobbies. The main focus will be on developing an awareness of some simple Chinese characters while writing and also how to pronounce words accurately. In addition, students will also explore a general understanding of two traditional Chinese festivals.

### Year Five and Year Six

Students will learn to express their personal information and their family/friends' through speaking and writing. They will learn to put together a short conversation in question and answer format asking about name, age, grade, nationality, favourite food and personal interest(s). The main focus will be on developing skills to the awareness of some simple Chinese character writing and also how to pronounce words accurately. In addition, students will also explore a general understanding of two traditional Chinese festivals.
