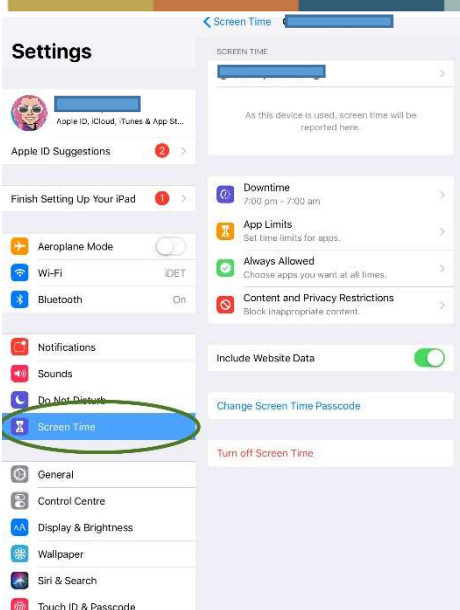


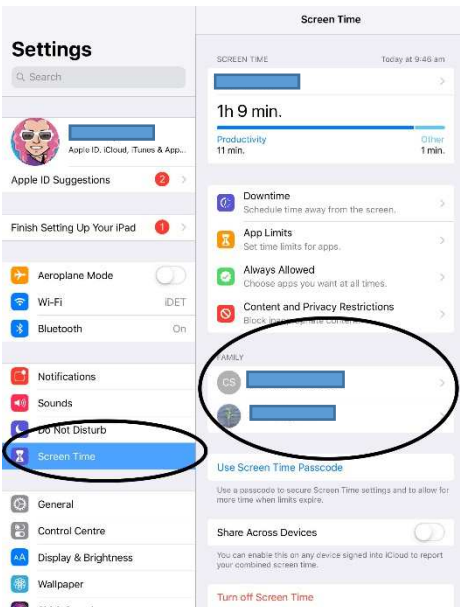
# Setting up Screen Time Restrictions

These instructions are only if you have already set up Family Sharing and Screen Time



## Step 1.

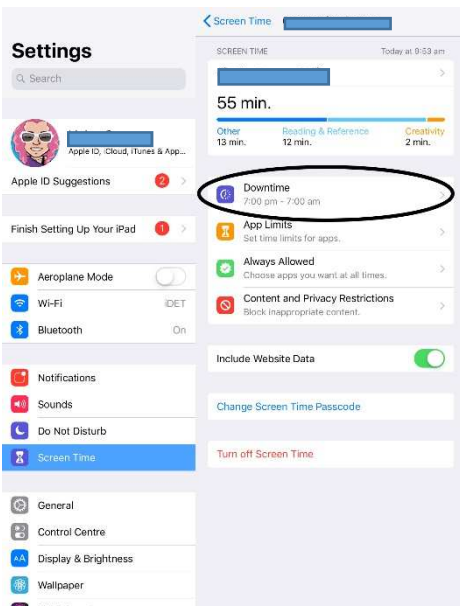
- In Settings, select *Screen Time*



## Step 2.

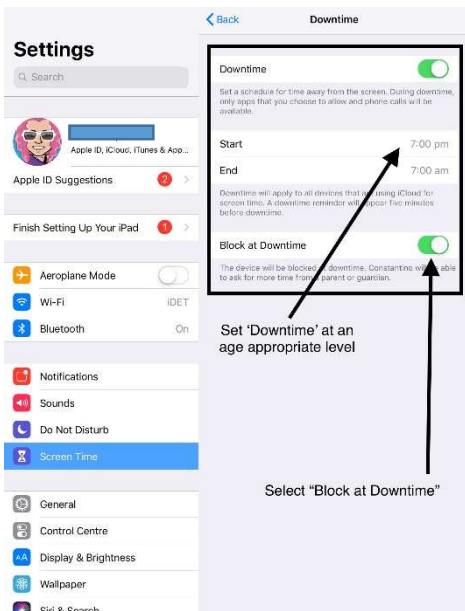
Each child must be set up with Screen Time Restrictions separately.

- Select one child to set up Screen Time Restrictions



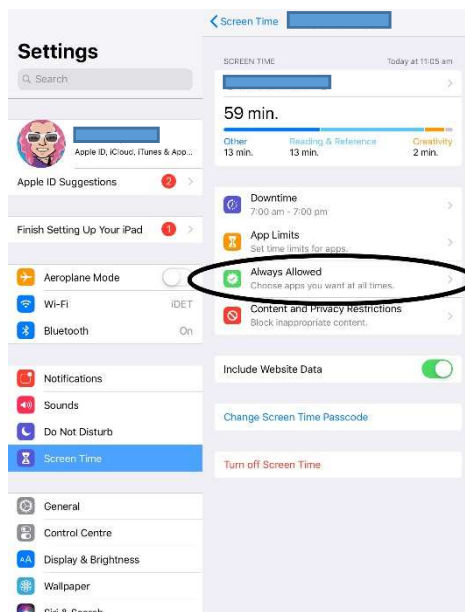
## Step 3.

- Select *Downtime*



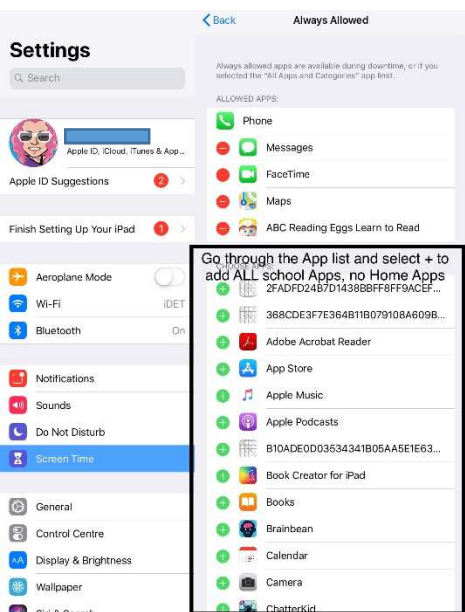
#### Step 4.

- Set Downtime at age appropriate level for your child
- Select *Block at Downtime*
- Select *< Back*



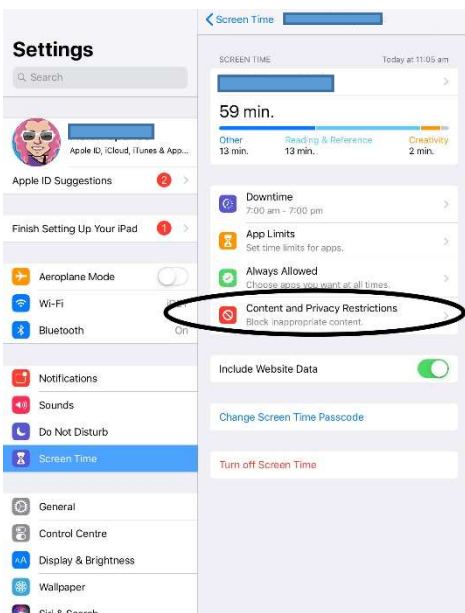
#### Step 5.

- Select *Always Allowed*



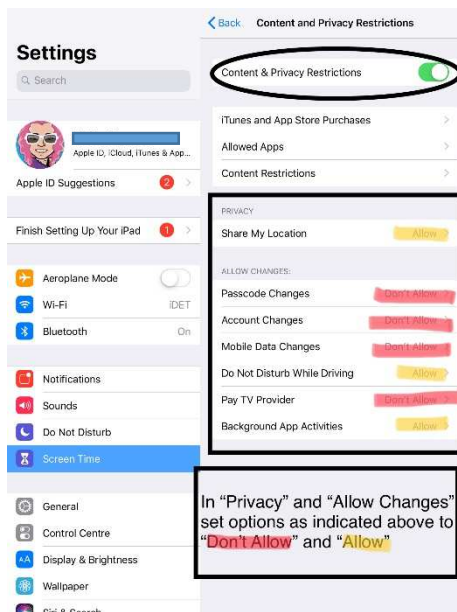
#### Step 6.

- Scroll to find *Choose Apps*
- Select + to select all School Apps
- Select *< Back*



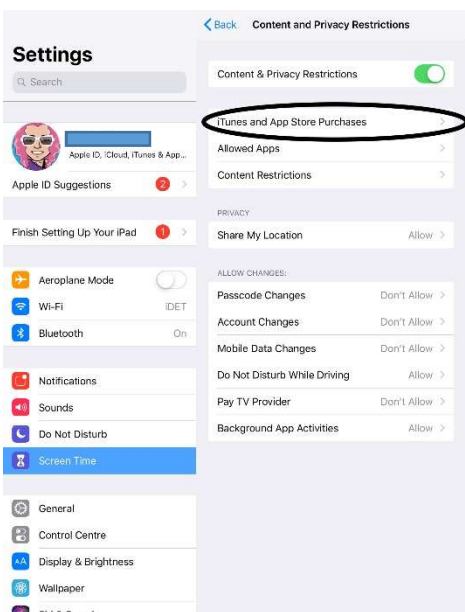
### Step 7.

- Select *Content and Privacy Restrictions*



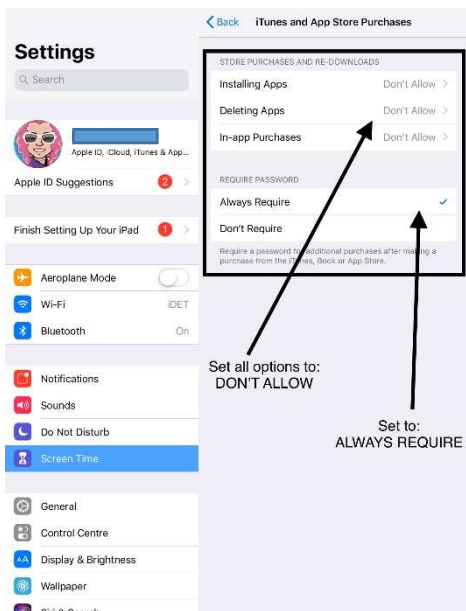
### Step 8.

- Swipe *Content and Privacy Restrictions* to green
- Set *Privacy* and *Allow Changes* options to 'Do not allow' and 'allow' as indicated
- Click *< Back*



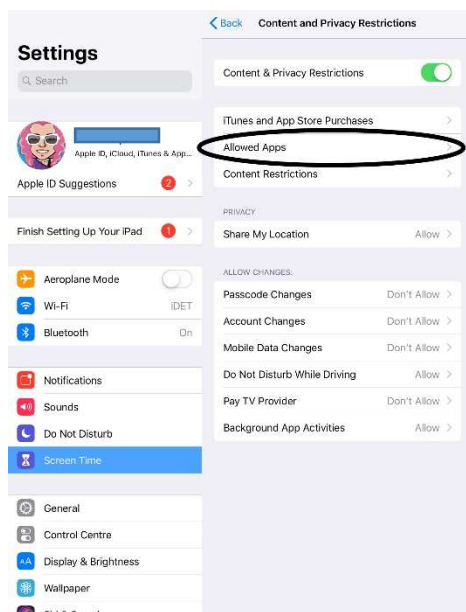
### Step 9.

- Select *iTunes and App Store Purchases*



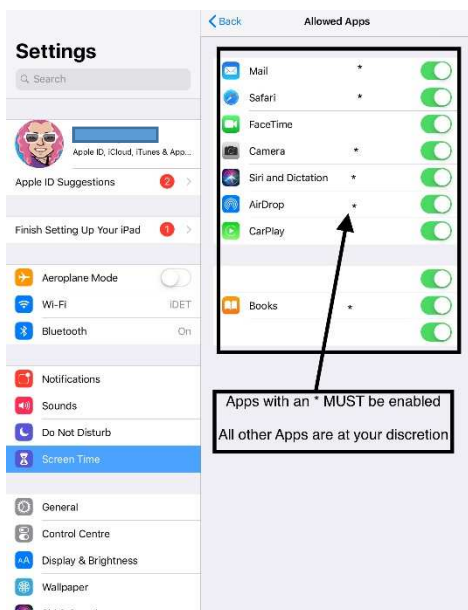
### Step 10.

- Set all options to *Don't Allow*
- Set 'Require Password' to *Always*
- Select < *Back*



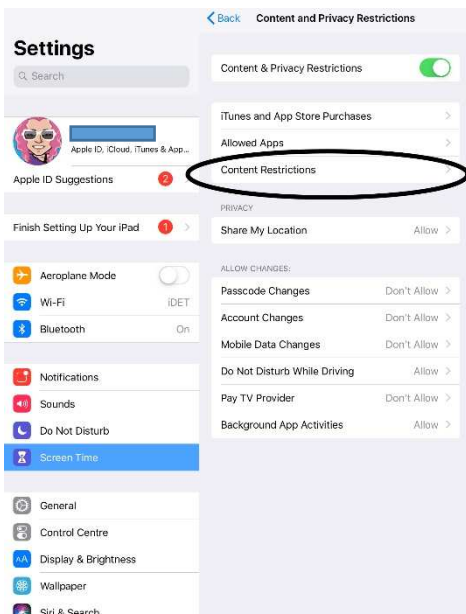
### Step 11.

- Select *Allowed Apps*



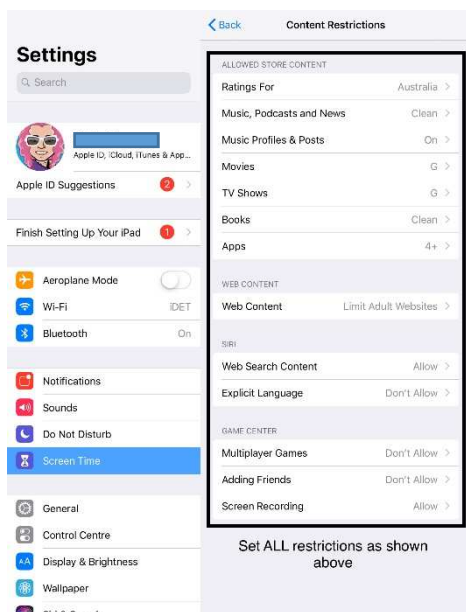
### Step 12.

- Swipe the following \* Apps to green
  - Mail
  - Safari
  - Camera
  - Siri and Dictation
  - AirDrop
  - Books
- All other Apps are at your discretion
- Select < *Back*

- Select *Content Restrictions*

- Set ALL restrictions as shown in the image



## Correcting Apple ID Birthdates

If you set up an Apple ID for your child prior to 2016 you could not enter their correct birth year as you had to be over 13 years old.

In 2016, Apple created Child Apple ID's which came with some security features, such as your child can not download Apps that have an age requirement above their own age.

Your child's birth date MUST be set to their actual age to ensure functionality of the restrictions feature. Please phone Apple Support on 1300 321 456 and follow the prompts to speak with an Apple Consultant to change their date of birth.
