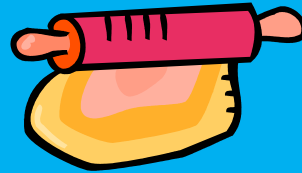


## Fun Sight Word Activities

Copy a sight word – use coloured pencils, magnetic letters or letters cut out from magazines/ newspapers.



Make your sight words with cookie-dough or playdough.



Sticky tape each sight word to a cushion. Spread them around the house and have children find each word and say them.



Copy the sight words twice onto pieces of cardboard or paper and play snap or memory.



Write the sight words onto cards and peg them onto string as they learn them.



Write each sight word on a mirror using textas or whiteboard pens.



Copy a sight word – cut the word up into individual letters, then put the word back together.



Put the sight words on a wall and 'swat' them with a fly swatter
