**Under this agreement for 2021
Alger State School will receive**

\$360 924

This funding will be used to ensure

- 90% of students in all year levels will achieve a C or above in academic reporting for English, Maths, Science and Behaviour each semester.
- 50% of students will achieve in the top two grades, e.g., A, B in each class per semester in English, Maths and Science.
- 90% of students will achieve the year level semester reading benchmark as outlined in the School's Assessment Framework each semester.
- 90% of all students like being at school.
- 90% of students think behaviour is well managed.
- 90% of students feel they are accepted by other students.
- 60% of NCCD (students identified in the Nationally Consistent Collection of student disability Data) students achieve a C or above in English and Maths.

Our initiatives include

- Implementation of targeted intervention programs to support students with reading difficulties:
 - Rip-It-Up Reading
 - Mini-Lit
 - Macq-Lit
 - Oral Language Programs
- Provision of extra adult support to develop the reading capabilities of students through the Flying Squad. Trained teacher aides deliver guided reading, decoding and comprehension skills in small groups as part of reading programs developed by classroom teachers.
- Employment of additional teacher aides to support Positive Behaviour Program and STEM Program.
- Enhance case management and program design with additional Speech Language time (1 day/week) and teacher aide time.




Our school will improve student outcomes by
