Privacy Statement

On 15 May to 19 May 2023, Year Six students are invited to attend Tallebudgera Beach School Camp as part of our Year Six Curriculum program.

The aims of the excursion are to fulfil many educational outcomes at the camp, including team building skills, co-operation skills and problem solving skills.

Excursion details:

- Depart: 8.30am - Monday 15 May 2023
- Return: 2.30pm - Friday 19 May 2023
- Students will be participating in bushwalking, canoeing, tobogganing, body boarding and surf awareness activities. Students will wear a surf wet suit for body boarding and a life vest for any canoeing or tobogganing activities. More information is available from the Tallebudgera Beach School website.
- Supervision will be provided by Camp School Staff and Algester State School Staff with Students placed into Activity Groups of approximately 20 students.
- Transport : Bus with seat belts.
- Accommodation is provided by Tallebudgera Beach School.
